**SUBJECT: January 11, 2011 Progress Report #89 on Butte County General Plan 2030**

This memo is the 89<sup>th</sup> in a series of updates provided to the Board of Supervisors at the beginning of each meeting to assist Board members in staying apprised of the progress on the Butte County General Plan 2030 process. I have the following developments to report:

**1. Zoning Ordinance Schedule**

General Plan 2030 staff is in the process of reviewing all of the requests, recommendations and information received during the eight Planning Commission meetings held on the new Draft Zoning Ordinance. The Planning Commission edited many sections of the Zoning Ordinance at each of these meetings. However, additional staff work is still required to review public requests, follow-up on Planning Commission recommendations, and assemble a second Draft Zoning Ordinance for the Planning Commission’s review. The Planning Commission would also like to receive policy guidance from the Board on a number of questions that arose during their review. This schedule includes the circulation of a Supplementary EIR that will address the environmental review of the Zoning Ordinance. The following tentative schedule has been developed, which will be updated in future Board Updates:
